**Security Alert  
Regarding Suspicious E-mail Using Zeon's Name**

Zeon Corporation

Zeon Corporation has confirmed several incidents involving a suspicious e-mail message purportedly sent by employees using a company e-mail account, "@zeon.co.jp."

The e-mail expresses the company's intention of placing an order for a large project and requests a reply from the recipient. Neither Zeon Corporation nor Zeon Group companies have any association with this e-mail.

Zeon has already responded to inquiries from recipients, informing them that no such employees work at the company and that the e-mail is fraudulent with no record of having been sent by corporate e-mail servers. However, similar messages may be falsely attributed to Zeon or its employees in the future.

In the event that you receive an e-mail attributed to Zeon that appears suspicious in any way, including questionable senders, subject lines, or content, do not respond to the message. Make sure to file an inquiry with the company by contacting the staff member in charge or by using the contact form on the Zeon corporate website.
